Scripture reflection: St Paul to the Ephesians 3;14-21

"This then is what I pray kneeling before the Father, from whom every family, whether spiritual or natural, takes its name.

Out of his infinite glory may he give you the power through his Spirit for your hidden self to grow strong, so that Christ may live in your hearts through faith, and then planted in love and built on love, you will with all the saints have strength to grasp the breadth and the length, the height and the depth; until knowing the love of Christ, which is beyond all knowledge, you are filled with the utter fullness of God. Glory be to him whose power working in us can do infinitely more than we can ask or imagine; glory be to him from generation to generation in the Church and in Christ Jesus for ever and ever Amen".

Silently reflect on the scripture for a few minutes and share some thoughts prompted by it.


What do we want to say about the topics sorted out last week? What do we want to send to a parish meeting/Parish Committee/Australian Plenary Council Committee?

Scripture Reflection: 1 Corinthians 12; 4-8,11

The Particular way in which the Spirit is given to each person is for a good purpose.....All these are the work of the one and the same Spirit, who distributes different gifts to different people just as he chooses."

Listening-discerning

"What is God asking of the Church in Australia at this time?"

It is therefore suggested that this involves four meetings/gatherings.

Week 2: Discerning what those stories are telling us.

Week3: What do we want to do with what we have discerned.

Week 4: Gathering up all the discernments and sharing them as

Church. (ie. This is what the Spirt is saying to us)

"Since the Spirit is our life, let us be directed by the Spirit" (Galatians 5,25).

Scripture reflection: John17; 11-21.

May they be one in us as you are in me and I am in you, so that the world may believe it was you who sent me."

Silently reflect on the scripture for a few minutes and then share some thoughts prompted by it.

Share your story of spirituality / faith – What do you want to say to the church. Do you think God is happy with the church? What do you think God would want to say to the church?

When you go home - reflect on these stories as well as your own Is there anything you think we need to take further.

Week 2: Discerning

Scripture reflection: John 15;26, 16;13-15.

"When the Advocate comes whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who issues from the Father, he will be my witness......When the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth since he will not be speaking as from himself but will say only what he has learnt and he will tell you of the things to come.....All he tells you will be taken from what is mine".

Silently reflect on the scripture for a few minutes and share some thoughts prompted by it..

Share what you think we need to take further from the first meeting for this discernment meeting.

Can we agree on some headings/topics that we can discuss and think that need to be taken further to the leaders of the Church..

Do you have any commendations/recommendations from the group?

When you go home -

reflect upon and pray about the discernment process. What do you want your experience of Church to be in the future?
