Something to Think About

Imagine you are sitting on the top of a mountain.
What can you see? What do you hear? What can you smell? How do you feel?

The Story

In today's gospel, Jesus takes his closest friends with him and goes up a mountain where they can be alone and pray. Jesus is transformed right before their eyes, and his clothes became shining white. Moses and Elijah, who lived long before Jesus, appear from heaven beside Jesus. A cloud passes over everyone on the mountain, and the voice of God comes from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, and I love him. Listen to what he says."

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark 9:2-10

Jesus took Peter, James, and John with him.
They went up on a high mountain, where they could be alone.
There in front of the disciples, Jesus was completely changed.
And his clothes became much whiter than any bleach on earth could make them.
Then Moses and Elijah were there talking with Jesus.

Peter said to Jesus, "Teacher, it is good for us to be here! Let us make three shelters, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But Peter and the others were terribly frightened, and he did not know what he was talking about.

The shadow of a cloud passed over and covered them.
From the cloud a voice said, "This is my Son, and I love him. Listen to what he says!"
At once the disciples looked around, but they saw only Jesus.

As Jesus and his disciples were coming down the mountain, he told them not to say a word about what they had seen, until the Son of Man had been raised from death.
So they kept it to themselves.

But they wondered what he meant by the words "raised from death."

All: Lord hear our prayer.


Invite the children to pray for their own special intentions.

cotton wool, glue*


Read the scripture quote on the template sheet with the children.

Ask them if they remember who spoke these words in the gospel story.


Children cover their cloud with glue and then stick on the cotton wool.
